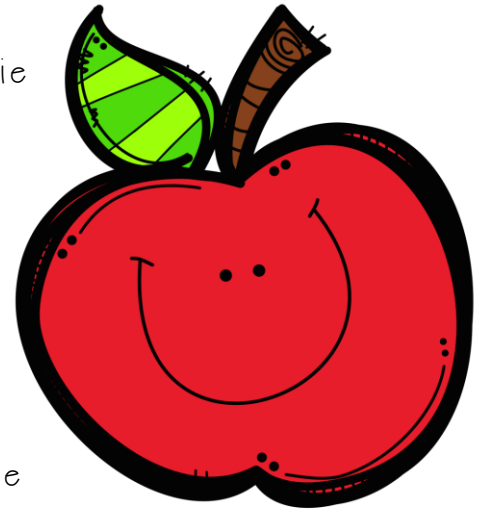


Dear First Grade Viking Families,

## Suggested Supply List

- 2 boxes of tissues
- 1 package of 24 Crayola colored pencils
