Back to School Supplies

Backpack

Crayons (16 count)

One box each, #2 pencils & cap erasers

Colored pencils-16 count (we use these daily)

At least five glue sticks

Student scissors

One orange, heavy-duty, plastic pocket folder with prongs

One yellow, heavy-duty, plastic pocket folder with prongs

One blue, heavy-duty, plastic pocket folder with prongs

Three, 100-page, college rule, composition books (with a plain, sturdy cover)

Two highlighters & two dry erase markers

One box facial tissues & one container of cleaning wipes

No markers please!

It is not necessary to label items individually as I will have labels for the folders and composition books and we share all of the consumable supplies as a classroom community. You may write your child’s name on their pencil box with a Sharpie if you like. The students will keep these in their desks. Please feel free to bring in donations during back to school night or on the first day of school. *Please do not fill pencil boxes with items, as we will do that as a class on the first day.*
