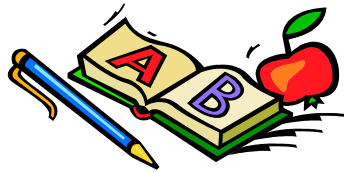
boards of both National Charity League, Moon Valley Chapter and Boys Team Charity.
