

Welcome to Ms. Jacky's Jellyfish



Special Needs Preschool 2019-2020



My name is Jacky Krzak and I will be your child's preschool teacher this year – if you are returning from last year... welcome back!!! I hope you have had a wonderful summer! I have been working hard getting our classroom ready for a great year of fun and learning!

Here are a few frequently asked questions to help you prepare for your child's first day of school:

When is the first day of school? Monday, August 5th.

What are the start and dismissal times? The morning class meets from 8:15-10:45. The afternoon class meets from 11:30-2:00. If you are new to my program, Search to Serve should have told you which program your child will be attending.

What does my child need for school? Your child will need a full-sized backpack (one that can hold a binder) and a change of clothes. If your child is not yet potty-trained, please send diapers and wipes. Please dress your child in comfortable clothing that they can easily move around and get a little dirty in. Socks and shoes are recommended every day and girls should wear shorts or leggings under dresses. It is against dress code to wear spaghetti straps or flip flops.

What are the procedures for picking up and dropping off my child at school?

AM – You will need to park in the large visitors lot and walk your child to the main gate and wait until the gate closes at 8:15 before saying goodbye to your child. This is a very busy time at the school so please allow yourself enough time for traffic, etc. One of my assistants will be at the gate, however, you may not leave your child with them because they are on duty and can't give the children their full attention until they close the gate. PM – we pick up out in front of the school. You can just pull up and park in the drive through lane (no need to park in the parking lot as this is not a busy time of day at school.)

AM dismissal, PM arrival and dismissal is at the front of the school. Again, you can just pull up in the drive through lane and wait for us to walk out. You do not need to worry about parking in the parking lot.

Will my child have a chance to eat at school? Every child receives a free breakfast or lunch and that is one of the first things that we do with the children after they get to school. If your child has allergies, please send a doctor's note on the first day of school and a special meal will be prepared for them. You can send a packed meal for them if you prefer.

What should I do if my child cries on the first day of school? A lot of children (especially the younger ones or children who have never attended school before) cry and try to cling on to their moms/dads/caregivers. In this case it is best to smile, wave and make a quick

departure. If you are excited for your child to start their first day of school they will catch on to your mood.

When will the bus pick up my child? (For bus riders only) The Transportation Department will send you a postcard with pick up and drop off times. Please note that the first few weeks of school are hectic for transportation and they may be earlier or later than what they specified on the post card. Please be patient and after a week or two they will arrive on a more predictable schedule. But even then student absences or new students added to their routes will change their pick up and drop off times. If you have any questions about your child's transportation plan, please call transportation at 602-896-5270.
