- Outdoor dining with a parent begins next week. Remember, only two friends and your child. We also ask that due to allergies and diet restrictions, parents only bring food for their child.

Be sure to have your email address on file with the front office. We have implemented a new electronic flyer distribution system, Peachjar. We also use home emails to mass communicate important information.

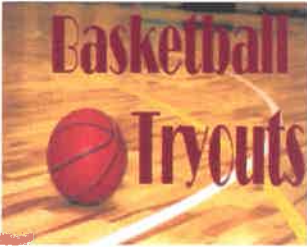
